Give a reason for your answer.

..... 0.46

..... Because $0.46 = 0.460$ and 460 thousandths is
greater than 406 thousandths.

..... 2.33, 2.303, 2.3, 2.03 (1)

three-digit number.

(Use each digit at most once.)

..... 973 (1)

11. Using the digits 0, 3, 6 and 8, two two-digit numbers
are formed.

Each digit is used once. Neither number can start with 0.
Find the smallest possible sum.
